Photo Critique of “Transport” Images

At 7:00 PM Thursday, February 16 the Land of Waterfalls Camera Club meeting will feature a critique of member photos with the theme “Transport”. Jeff Miller, a professional photographer who is highly esteemed for his ability to enlighten and entertain his photographer audience, will be “live” via Zoom.

The theme of “Transport” was chosen to challenge and focus the creative abilities of the members. Transport can be interpreted differently by each of the photographers. To many it can be images of trains, boats, cars, trucks, wagons, planes, or even wheelbarrows. To others it can vary from a mother walking with her baby lovingly wrapped to her chest, to a child enjoying his or her first pony

ride. Industrially it can evoke images of fast conveyor belts conveying materials from one bin to another or a large, long oil pipeline. Some photographers look to nature to capture the transport of delicate seeds in the air or birds carrying food in their beaks to feed their young.

The number of images captured within the theme of Transport can be endless. The variety of final images displayed will make for interesting viewing.

Jeff Miller will have reviewed all the images (without knowing the identity of the photographer) beforehand and will present his appraisal of the individual images. This valuable learning experience will not simply look at focus, level horizontal alignment (a favorite of Jeff's),

or correct exposure. He will highlight the essence of how the photographer captured the timing, the color, the texture, the leading lines, the composition, the lighting, and/or the dynamic features of the scene.



This can be simple constructive hints or examples of how he would do it. The whole process affords the photographer an independent (and unbiased) view of his or her work. Others can better themselves by learning from the work and critiques of others.
